### **Inspections of Psychiatric and Rehabilitation centres of Islamabad Capital Territory**

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) on Wednesday carried out inspections of 4 psychiatric and rehabilitation centres of Islamabad.

IHRA issued notices to two centres over violations of Covid-19 SOPs and for keeping multiple patients in a limited space. The centres were directed by the inspection teams to comply with the guidelines.

IHRA suspended the services of two psychiatric and rehabilitation centres for keeping multiple patients in a limited space, unqualified staff, poor hygiene and ventilation, for keeping people captive in the facility and unethical medical practices. The centres were directed to discharge all local patients within three hours and out-station patients within five days and are kept under surveillance under further orders.
