IHRA sealed five healthcare establishments over malpractices

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) has sealed five healthcare establishments in different areas of ICT.

As per details, IHRA inspection teams carried out inspections of 24 Healthcare Establishments (HCEs) in different areas of Islamabad Capital Territory during the past two weeks.

Ali health clinic, Imtiaz clinic, Abuzar family clinic, Faisal clinic and Anwar Capital hospital were sealed due to different malpractices like absence of qualified medical staff, unhygienic conditions, administering expired medicines and used syringes to patients and keeping the medical facility functional despite suspension orders from the Authority.

IHRA suspended the services of Peace Rehab Centre and Sidra Akhter Foundation over different non-compliances like not maintaining patient's files and absence of psychiatrist and medical staff.

Nine Healthcare Establishments were served notices for minor non-compliances and instructed to comply with the directions given by inspections team.

The spokesperson also added that five HCEs were recommended for registration and revocation of suspension. Three HCEs were found closed upon arrival by inspection teams.
