CIRCULAR

The Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) is concerned about the number of cases of Dengue patient will increase in coming days, and desires to draw the attention of Healthcare Establishments (HCEs) towards the matter to cope-up with the Dengue outbreak in Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT).

In light of this situation, HCEs are directed to ensure the allocation of a considerable number of beds in wards (isolated as per the Standard Operating Procedure). Additionally, ensure the presence of dedicated, trained, and skilled staff, as well as the availability of specialized laboratory equipment and Dengue test kits for screening and testing of Dengue patients to effectively address this situation.

HCEs are hereby again intimated to promptly upload information about positive Dengue Patients on PITB dashboard and must follow the IHRA notified rate list for Dengue patients and display it at a prominent place.
