Subject: DIRECTIVES REGARDING READINEES FOR DENGUE OUTBREAK

The Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) has observed that the number of Dengue cases have increased and there are chances of exponential rise. IHRA wants to draw the attention of all Healthcare Establishments (HCEs) to this matter, in order to effectively manage the upcoming Dengue outbreak in the Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT).

In view of the above mentioned situation, IHRA directs all the HCE's of ICT, in the best of public interest, that;

- 1. Ensure the allocation of a certain number of beds for Dengue patients, as per the isolation SOPs.
- 2. Ensure the presence of dedicated, trained, skilled staff and provide them with refresher training.
- 3. Develop standees and posters for Dengue awareness, prevention, and actions to take when symptoms develop and place them at appropriate sites within the HCE.
- 4. Strictly follow the IHRA notified rate list for Dengue patients and display it prominently:

i. CBC:

100 PKR

ii. NS1 Elisa:

1800 PKR

IHRA inspection teams will periodically inspect the HCEs to ensure compliance with these directives.
